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1. REQUIREMENTS OF YEP-GO

Project Framework

Youth Expedition Project (YEP) is a Service-Learning programme by Youth Corps Singapore (YCS) to nurture confident and resilient youths who are active citizens with the desire to make a difference both at home and overseas.

The objectives of YEP are to develop:

1. confident and resilient youths who are able to work in teams;
2. caring youths who actively seek to improve the lives of others both at home and overseas through sustainable Service-Learning projects;
3. Asia-Ready youths who are socially and culturally aware and able to forge friendships in the ASEAN member states, China and India.

In view of the recent developments pertaining to COVID-19, the National Youth Council (NYC) is implementing a series of precautionary measures, to safeguard the health and safety of all youth participants.

NYC is adhering closely to the travel advisories issued by Ministry of Health (MOH), and stand advised against travel to affected countries and regions. In view of the regional Covid situation and the preparation time needed for partners to plan for the trip, NYC will extend the travel advisories against YEP trips to 31 Dec 2020. NYC will not be accepting any applications nor approving grants for YEP trips (including recce trips) taking place before 31 Dec 2020.

Launch of new YEP Goes Online

The new YEP Goes Online (**YEP-GO**) provides a platform for youths to continue volunteering with the overseas communities without travel. Youths can connect with overseas partner organisations to develop programmes such as online classes, trainings or skilled volunteering through virtual means.

YEP-GO provides youths with opportunities to:

1. Do Good for Overseas Communities (Positive Impact);
2. Forge Bonds with Youths from Overseas Host Countries (Lasting Friendship);
3. Join Online Dialogues with NGOs, Social Enterprises, Singaporeans Working & Living Overseas (Continual Learning).

A YEP-GO should:

- Involve communities in the ASEAN member states, India and China;
- Be endorsed by an Endorsing Organisation (EO) which is a recognised education institution or not-for-profit organisation based and registered in Singapore;
- Complete three key phases, i.e. *Preparation, Online Project and Project Closure*.

Team Composition

Team Leader(s) and Members

- Teams must meet the following Team Composition:

1 Team Leader	4 - 7 Team Members (excluding Team Leader)
2 Team Leaders	8 - 12 Team Members (excluding Team Leaders)

- Teams which wish to accommodate a bigger team size and/or deviate from the stipulated Team Composition above are required to indicate in the Proposal.

* In the event of any failure to achieve the project deliverables or fulfil the grant conditions, NYC reserves the right to withhold or adjust the grant amount at its sole discretion.

Non-Qualifying Expenses

- ▶ Fundraising costs;
- ▶ IT equipment such as laptops, smartphones, monitors, projector, camera;
- ▶ Gifts (e.g. welfare packs); Donations (in cash or in-kind);
- ▶ Meals/ snacks for YEP-GO team;
- ▶ Workshop/ training fees for YEP-GO team;
- ▶ Costs that are not related to online engagement.

Qualifying Expenses

Online Project Costs

- ▶ IT network for overseas community, e.g. routers, WIFI;
- ▶ Resources for online engagement (e.g. Zoom subscriptions for both SG/overseas, up to 6 months);
- ▶ Overseas partners coordination fees (capped at \$300);
- ▶ Accommodation, meals and transport for overseas youths (if commuting to the community is necessary);
- ▶ Interpreter / Translator (if necessary);
- ▶ Resource person fees, e.g. engaged counsellor/ psychologist expertise on mental health workshop (capped at \$200);
- ▶ Team Bonding (capped at \$10/pax);

The preceding lists of qualifying and non-qualifying costs are non-exhaustive and may be approved at the sole discretion of NYC on a case-by-case basis.

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Grant Application

- Teams should put “YEP-GO” in their project title. E.g. “YEP-GO Team Chang”.
- The YEP-GO grant application should be submitted via <https://go.gov.sg/yepgoapplication> **at least 2 months before the start date of the Online Project.**
- Teams that require assistance to fine-tune their proposals are encouraged to send the YEP Proposal to yep_enquiries@nyc.gov.sg **before** the 2-month submission timeline and factor in adequate time to amend the proposal.
- The following documents must be duly completed and submitted for the grant application:
 - (i) YEP-GO Endorsement
 - (ii) YEP-GO Proposal & Budget
 - (iii) YEP-GO Team Name List
 - (iv) [YEP-GO Leaders Pre Feedback Form](#) (Online)
 - (v) [YEP-GO Members Pre Feedback Form](#) (Online)

2. THINGS TO NOTE AFTER GRANT APPROVAL

Teams can visit the Youth Corps Singapore Website (<https://www.youthcorps.gov.sg/en/initiative/#youth-expedition-project>) for the most updated details on the YEP-GO programme or on any changes to the YEP-GO policies and requirements.

Disbursement of Grant

- An approval email will be sent to the Team Leaders, with the Endorsing Organisation (EO) kept in the loop. Team Leaders are to acknowledge the approved grant amount and the grant conditions.
- The grant amount will be disbursed upon verification that the project was implemented in accordance with the original proposal and of the project expenses incurred.
- In the event of any failure to achieve the project deliverables or fulfil the grant conditions, NYC reserves the right to withhold or adjust the grant amount at its sole discretion.

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Project Publicity

- NYC's support should be acknowledged on all publicity materials from date of award of the grant. Teams are required to credit Youth Corps Singapore (YCS), part of National Youth Council (NYC), and Youth Expedition Project (YEP) in all media and publicity related materials released in conjunction with the project. These include, but are not limited to online publicity, such as electronic direct mailers, Facebook and websites, traditional publicity platforms, such as banners, posters, brochures and direct mailers, as well as media-profiling opportunities such as media features and interviews.
- Note: High-resolution YEP-YCS logo can be downloaded from the Youth Corps Singapore Website (<https://www.youthcorps.gov.sg/en/initiative/#youth-expedition-project>). The use of logos shall be as follows:



- All artwork, as well as media and publicity related materials, must be sent to yep_enquiries@nyc.gov.sg before production or release. NYC reserves the right to use the materials for publicity purposes.
- To amplify your team's good work and compile all YEP-GO teams' experiences, we encourage you to hashtag **#YEPsg**, **#YouthCorpsSG**, **#NYCsg** and **#SGYouthCares** for your social media postings.

Changes to Project

- NYC must be informed in writing of major changes to the proposed project at least 2 weeks before the project execution date (e.g. objective, overseas host partner, beneficiary, budget, etc.). Minor changes can be updated in the project report at project closure.
- NYC reserves the right to withdraw or reduce funding if the project deviates significantly from the original proposal.
