



Take note that the list provided is not exhaustive. Feel free to explore other collaborations where possible.

UNDERSTAND YOUR ROLE AS A LEADER



Being a YEP-GO leader is definitely not easy and there are certain expectations to meet.

You should be expected to:

- Have the maturity to lead a team of mixed ages (15-35 years old)
- Be responsive and demonstrate ability to manage local and international stakeholders
- Provide direction and confidence in leading team through ambiguity
- Be passionate in the development of team members

FORM YOUR TEAM

Now that you have secured a community partner and have a potential idea in mind, it's time for you to recruit some help!



PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- What is your project scope?
- What is the success of the project?
- · How long are the commitment hours?
- What are the members' roles?
- What are the funding requirements from members?


INTERVIEW YOUR MEMBERS

- Find out about interested volunteers' working style
- How are their time management skills?
- Do they have any other skills that will help to bring success to the project?

ORIENTATION

- Help your members be familiar with one another's working style
- Set up a communication platform and regular meeting time
- · Allocate member's role in the project





- Publicise your recruitment (eg. whatsapp blast/social media)
- Set up interview slots (preferably at least 2 days)
- Come up with a description of your project objectives

SELECT YOUR MEMBERS


- Form a team where everyone would be able to work well together!
- Take note of individuals' commitments during the project period and foresee if any of them might face difficulties in committing







APPLY FOR THE YEP-GO GRANT



You may review the requirements for the YEP-GO grant and apply for it. NYC will fund 80% of total qualifying project costs, capped at \$3,000 per team.

BRING YOUR PROJECT SUCCESS



Set up a meeting agenda for each check-in with members to keep track of project progress.

Liaise with overseas community partners to find out more information needed for preparation.

Be confident and believe in your team to be committed in the deliverables. Grow together as a team while serving others, the journey will be worthwhile.

STEP 6 PROJECT CLOSURE



Facilitate debrief to anchor members' learning and review feedback as a team.

Finally, complete and submit all project closure forms for the grant to be processed successfully.
